Excess oil was removed from the skim pit. The metal cage was removed and recycled. Impacted soils beneath the skim pit were excavated. Oily soils were transported to Waste Management Denver-Aurora Disposal Site (DADS) for disposal.

Other impacted soils were placed in three bermed areas on the lease and landfarmed.
