CONTROL PERMIT**

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE:

The purpose of this notice is to solicit public comment on the Cascade Creek #604-12-13 disposal well, a Class II injection permit submitted by Laramie Energy LLC. The Cascade Creek #604-12-13 disposal well will be drilled at a location 2,804 feet from north line and 396 feet from west line of Section 4, Township 6 South, Range 97 West, 6th P.M., Garfield County, Colorado.

BACKGROUND

Class II injection wells are permitted and regulated in such a manner as to prevent the contamination of underground sources of drinking water and to ensure fluid emplacement and confinement within the permitted injection zones. Class II injection wells are permitted to inject waste generated from oil and gas exploratory and production operations. Laramie Energy LLC proposes to inject these fluids into the Ohio Creek and Williams Fork Formations in a cased-hole completion at approximately 6,288-6,550 feet MD and 6,700-6,702ft MD respectively.

Public comments are encouraged and will be accepted, in writing at the Commission for a period of thirty (30) days after publication of this notice. If any data, information, or arguments submitted during the public comment period appear to raise substantial questions concerning proposed injection well permit, the Director may request that the Commission hold a hearing on the matter.

Additional information on the operation of the proposed injection well may be obtained at the Commission office.
