DETAILS OF WORK

Plan to rotary drill using low water loss mud. Set approximately 300' of 10-3/4" OD surface casing and circulate to surface with cement. Drill hole of sufficient size to set 5-1/2" OD casing to approximately 6500' to explore formations above the upper Fort Union Zone and set 5-1/2" casing should commercial zones be discovered.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
