Extraction Oil & Gas, Inc. (Extraction) is planning to drill the following 4 horizontal wells:

Raindance 29E-10-1C Doc # 401542958	Raindance 29E-10-3N Doc # 401544378
Raindance 29E-10-2N Doc # 401544089	Raindance 29E-20-4C Doc # 401544806

Please let this letter serve as a request for administrative approval of an exception location for the captioned oil and gas wells. Extraction Oil & Gas, Inc. (Extraction) is planning to drill the above referenced horizontal wells at a surface location outside a legal drilling window as defined by Rule 318A.a and farther than 50 feet from an existing well as defined by Rule 318A.c.

Rule 318A.a of the Colorado Oil and Gas Commission's Rules and Regulations requires wells to be drilled in a square with sides 400 feet in length, the center of which is the center of any quarter/quarter section or in the center of any quarter section with the four sides being 800 feet in length. Extraction proposes to drill the above referenced wells at a surface location outside a legal drilling window.

Rule 318A.c of the COGCC's Rules and Regulations requires any new twinning well to be located within fifty (50) feet of an existing well. The above-named wells are more than fifty (50) feet from the nearest existing oil and gas well.

The location of the above referenced well has been determined per the surface owner's request. Waivers of the subject rules have been signed by the surface owner are enclosed for your review.
