Gentlemen:

In re Cherokee Air Drilling, Inc.

Reference is made to your letter dated July 13, 1959, in which you ask for an extension of time for filing required forms, and also request all of the forms necessary on the following state of facts: The wells were drilled and completed; all were dry as to oil. We understand that some little gas was found in two of the shallow wells, but the rock pressure and the volume were such that it was impossible to market the gas and the wells were capped, which we understand was the condition of all of the wells pending determination of the interested parties as to whether they would proceed with any sand fracturing, or other operational procedures."

We regret to hear that the president and vice president of the company were recently killed in an airplane crash. The time within which the forms may be filed is hereby extended from July 20 to July 30, 1959.

Enclosed please find a copy of our Rules and Regulations and forms necessary for compliance. In filling out the necessary forms, the following resume will be an aid to you:

Wells abandoned permanently or temporarily (reference is made to our Rule 332).

1. OGCC Form 4 - SUNDRY NOTICES AND REPORTS ON WELLS (Rule 305) - Is required for Notice of intention to abandon a well.

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2. OGCC Form 5 - WELL COMPLETION REPORT - (Rule 306) is required for all wells completed. The word "completed" as used herein is defined on page 6 of our Rules and Regulations (117). All of your wells apparently are "dry holes" in their present status. Since you have done work for abandoning, either temporary or permanent, this form should have been submitted within 30 days after the plugging (work) was done.

3. OGCC Form 6 - PLUGGING RECORD - (Rule 307) - For wells plugged or abandoned, reporting work done.

When the interested parties determine their next action, OGCC Form 4 should be submitted for notice of work to be done, and, depending upon whether or not the well has commercial value, either Form 4 or Form 6 will be required, giving a report of the work done.

If we can be of any further service in this matter, we will promptly cooperate with your pleasure.
