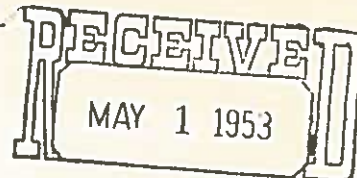

On April 24, 1953 above described well was drilled to a P. D. of
 243', on April 25th 163.67' of 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ " 32.75 and 28.04# H-40 Range 3
 casing was run and cemented at 175.67' KB with 165 sx regular cement
 2% Cacl. Cement was circulated to surface. Cement was allowed to set
 36 hours. Drilled cement below float collar and tested casing with
 600# psi ; there was no leaks so drilling was resumed.
