

Colorado State Logan County Dale Field

A-2 (Well No.) Haywood (Lease) NE/4 23 (Sec. and $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec.) 8N (Twp.) 53W (Range) --- (Meridian)

The well is located 330 ft. (NW) of N Line and 996 ft. (E) of (S)
East Line of NW/4 Section 23-8N-53W.

The elevation above sea level is 4059 ft.*

Details of Plan of Work: (State names of and expected depths to objective sands; Show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

We propose to plug and abandon the captioned well by spotting a cement plug from 4790 feet to 4600 feet opposite the 'Muddy' and Dakota sandstone. Heavy mud taken from the bottom of the mud pit will then be placed from 4600 feet to 620 feet, 15 feet below the bottom of the surface casing. A cement plug will be placed from 620 feet to 530 feet. Heavy mud will be placed to within 10 feet of the surface where a cement plug will be spotted to the surface in such a manner as not to interfere with surface cultivation.
