SandRidge has elected to conduct source removal of the impacted soil via dig and haul activities, scheduled to be done by November 1, 2018.

REMEDICATION SUMMARY

During dig and haul activities, soils from the excavation bottom will be screened for the presence of hydrocarbons with a photoionization detector (PID). Confirmation soil samples will be collected on the excavation bottom where the highest PID reading was detected (if applicable) at 15-foot intervals for BTEX, TPH-GRO, and TPH-DRO to determine that all impacted material have been properly removed. Impacted materials will be disposed of at a properly licensed disposal facility. Clean backfill material will be imported when confirmation soil samples confirm all impacted materials have been removed.
