As we have discussed, Enerplus Resources (USA) Corporation, ("Enerplus") has obtained permits to drill a well or wells, ("Wells") on the above described DSU. Pursuant to that certain Well Proposal Letter dated November 30, 2017, Great Western Oil & Gas Co ("GWOG") has elected to participate in the Wells.
