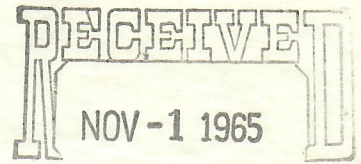



We received notice from the Davis Oil Company that on October 15, 1962, you purchased the UPRR-Middlemist Well No. 1, located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, Township 3 South, Range 57 West, in the Windy Hill field, Adams County, Colorado.

Our rules and regulations require that you, as a new operator in Colorado, submit the following:

- ✓ 1. Designation of Agent (Form OGCC-1)
- ✓ 2. \$2500 Bond on each well drilled or producing (Form OGCC-3)
- ✓ 3. Certificate of Clearance (Form OGCC-10) for each producing well

In addition to the above forms, we require monthly production reports (Form OGCC-7). These reports are due on the 25th of the month following the month of production; therefore, if you had any production in October, this report was due on or before November 25, 1962. Your November production was due to be submitted by December 25, 1962.

We are enclosing a copy of our Rules and Regulations, and the necessary forms for you to complete. Please submit these completed forms promptly, and feel free to contact us for information or for any forms required by our rules and regulations which you may need.
