Comment: Access road, subject of Variance Request, runs through site on the West perimeter. Vegetation on site is well established with a mix of grasses & forbes; some Crested wheat grass was noted in this mix, which may be a holdover from the old interim reclamation. One spot, bare and sparse of vegetation, approximately 20 ft X 20 ft, is at former well head or equipment position. Wattles are installed on East perimeter. A few Russian thistle plants and Cheat grass were noted on access road and in peripheral areas of site.
