
DETAILS OF WORK

Exploratory stratohole. This test well is to be drilled for stratigraphic and structural information to an approximate total depth of 1000'. Objective marker bed is the Mancos sand member of the Mancos shale, expected at approximately 1000'. After running a correlation electric log, the well will be properly plugged and abandoned. No important water or oil or gas formations are expected to be encountered.

Change of location is desired from original spot 730' FEL, 1214' FEL Sec. 17, approved by USGS 6-14-56.
