Hi Alex and Steven,

We have a plastic-lined containment built in one of our pipe laydown yards near the Parachute Creek Gas Plant. This was intended to store the contaminated dirt while we finish cleaning up the site and start our investigation around the rupture area. We would like to ask for your permission to move the dirt to this location.

When I try to submit a Sundry Notice Form 4 to make the request formally, it is asking for a facility ID #, which the release site does not have. Do you want me to use the Parachute Creek Gas Plant facility ID #? Or should we just correspond via email on this matter?

Also we are preparing to contact the downstream landowners, but legal would prefer to wait until tomorrow after we have data from the creek. Please let me know if this is acceptable.
