	Provide soil disposal manifests and a sample location drawing showing sample depths along with the laboratory data and reports on a supplemental eForm 27. Multiple supplemental reports may be submitted as necessary. Once all appropriate documentation has been provided, request "NFA" status on a supplemental eForm 27.
	Following backfilling the pit, ensure that an adequate seedbed has been established in order to facilitate final reclamation per Rule 1004.
	Collect one soil sample from each sidewall of the produced water pit and two samples from the bottom of the pit for BTEX and TPH. Sample the available pit berm material for pH, EC and SAR to ensure that any soil above Table 910-1 allowable levels for pH, EC and SAR are covered with a minimum of three feet of clean fill material.
	Collect soil samples from the four sidewalls and one sample from the base of the former oil skim pit excavation for BTEX and TPH laboratory analysis.
	Remove the remaining hydrocarbon impacted soil on the south wall of the former skim pit excavation.
