Dear Mr. Coghlin:

Reference is made to your letter of February 23, 1959, concerning the above well. The Conservation Commission has not issued any special rules as yet for the Doherty Field in which your well is located. According to our records the Anderson-State Well No. 1 is the only producible well in said field with two dry holes to the west.

According to our Form 10, completed by you and approved by our office on October 30, 1957, your well is capable of producing 24 barrels of oil and 250,000 Mcf of gas per day, which certainly would indicate a gas well.

Since you have apparently had successful negotiations for selling your gas from the well, and since there has been no development to the north, east or south of your well, we feel that it would be desirable to call a hearing on this matter to determine what the spacing unit and maximum rate of production should be. Unless we hear from you within the next few days, we shall initiate such hearing on our own motion.

Although you have made a test of your well, as indicated by the figures submitted on our Form 10 mentioned above, we have not received the details of such a test on our Form 9, which is required.

Also, we note that you produced your well for five months in 1957 for which months you submitted only the volume of oil produced and did not make an esti-

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mate of the volume of gas in accordance with instructions found on the back side of our Form 7.

We will sincerely appreciate your attending to these matters at your earliest convenience.
