Gentlemen:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of June 23, 1960, regarding your wells in the Ignacio-Blanco Field, La Plata County, Colorado.

Making reference first to the #2-16 King well in Section 16, Township 34 North (South of Ute), Range 8 West; since this well has not been drilled and it has been 180 days since original approval, a new intention will be necessary.

With regard to the #1-22 Davie well in Section 22, Township 34 North (South of Ute), Range 8 West, Designation of Agent is handled by a statement either included in the original intention or in a separate letter. Statements generally are in this form, that is, lease owned in entirety by subject company, or all interest pooled by signed agreement.

With regard to State requirements, I have enclosed a copy of our Rules and Regulations. Rule 317 will give you general drilling regulations. Unitization is under Rules 400 series.

Also, I have enclosed the special field rules #112-6, which is the rule governing spacing of the Ignacio-Blanco Field for all three formations; namely, Mesaverde, Fruitland Pictured Cliffs and Dakota-Morrison. Enclosed is Order #112-7 which deals with a forced pooling and is the only Order issued since #112-6.

I hope the above will answer any questions you have, and I will be awaiting a statement regarding the designation of unit for the #1-22 Davie well.
