

Justin,

We had our bi-weekly conference call with CPW this morning and Morning Gun's three locations in 7N59W and the PSTG survey was discussed. The good news is that no lek activity was observed this year. However, the proposed Access Road on the Form 2As for these three pads still cuts through the Restricted Surface Occupancy (RSO) area that is located near Weld County Road 119. Both CPW and COGCC wish to prevent any disturbance/activity in that RSO area year round and would like to see an alternate Access Road route for these three pads that avoids the RSO area before approving these permits. There is also some concern with any planned future drilling activity on these pads where lek activity may resume and how to best deal with that. When you get a chance will you contact me and John Noto to discuss these concerns.
