| Detailed description of the issue or issues. | <p>This morning from 7 am to 10:30 am there have been at least 50 dump truck trips hauling away dirt, going 50 feet from my house. There are so many huge dump trucks that they have to wait for each other on my corner and can't pass each other on the narrow privately owned lanes, so they are pulling over onto more private property, blocking our ingress and egress and sitting there spewing diesel fumes onto our property while they wait for each other.</p> <p>This Crestone Peak behavior is very different than the other plug and abandon projects. It is more intense and continuous, and as usual, horribly unsafe for this neighborhood as they are continually blocking the Rd. 18 egress and ingress to 6 families properties. There is one family that doesn't care but some of us do, as they are causing a safety hazard and destruction of our driveway.</p> <p>Additionally, they are working at the sight where the proposed facility Site for Regnier Farms 11 wells are sited, 1/2 mile from my house north. So I went to take a look. Indeed they are doing something there that is different than plugging</p> |

and abandoning. It looks like they might be preparing the site for the new Facility site. On the application it says they are to use a new road, a 1 mile trip, that is to go directly east off of East County Line Road for the development of this Facility site, not the 4 mile trip down 3 privately owned lanes.

Someone needs to investigate why they are using Rd. 18 and going 50 feet west of my house with all of this heavy industrial traffic, instead of using a new temporary road for this facility site. Crestone Peak and Regnier Farms continue to abuse this situation and cause distress when they could be using Regnier Farms access points on his parcels for all of his heavy Industrial traffic.

Additionally they are still working on the Regnier site on Sandstead's property so we are basically living in an Industrial zone right now due to this oversight on the COGCC's part. There are 3 horrible Industrial sites concurrently being worked on within 1/2-3/4 mile of my house.

Weld County does nothing to help us.

Why is Crestone Peak accessing the site for the new Facility site and using our neighborhood privately owned roads when they are not supposed to be doing that?
