Comment: There are two cattle guards along the access road that are filled in with sediment. The access road is not maintained and does not adequately drain stormwater. As a result, vehicles are traveling outside of the access road creating significant disturbance and soil compaction. There are barrels and buckets with lubricants with open lids with improper material handling and spill prevention. See Attached Photos

Corrective Action: Prevent vehicle disturbance outside of the access road and reclaim disturbance. Properly grade and install road base to allow stormwater drainage. Properly store and prevent spills. Install or repair required BMPs per Rule 1002.f.
