Comment:	Stuffing box leak of ~20 BBLs on location was reported to inspector at ~8 am on 6/7/2019. COGCC EPS, landowner and Lincoln County LGD were being contacted by D90's main office. Free fluids were removed from location by D&D; earth berms were put around stained soils at wellhead; and backhoe, loader and roustabouts were working to remove stained soil that will be put in rolloff containers and properly disposed of. Stained soil area between deadmen was ~100'x130'. Workover rig was still set up at wellhead and was being cleaned of oil. South wind blew oil mist onto winter wheat off location to the north side. See attached photos.
