

Dear Mr. Neslin:

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) hereby withdraws its protest, filed with the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) via letter dated August 11, 2009, in the above-captioned matter. The BLM has received an amended application for COGCC Order from Beatty & Wozniak, P.C., attorneys for Williams Production RMT Company that no longer contains a proposed approximate 640 acre drilling and spacing unit for the Williams Fork and Iles Formations consisting of Section 15, Township 7 South, Range 94 West, 6th P.M., Garfield County, Colorado.

This withdrawal does not constitute a waiver of BLM's rights under the Memorandum of Understanding between the Colorado BLM and the COGCC. Furthermore, this withdrawal does not constitute a waiver of BLM's ability to raise during consideration of matters brought before the COGCC, any argument asserted in the BLM letter of August 11, 2009.
