Germination was observed throughout most of the location; however, there are bare patches with no germination. It does not appear the Operator has performed weed management as weedy vegetation was observed throughout the location. COGCC staff previously communicated that it is the responsibility of the Operator to comply with Rule 1004 vegetation standards, including weed management. Operator will have to perform additional reclamation activities this Fall to address bare patches and any other areas that have not had successful germination of desirable species.
