INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

During decommissioning operations near the separator crew was removing flow line risers and discovered impacted media. Confirmation sidewall excavation samples were collected above the phreatic zone and submitted under proper chain of custody procedures to Summit Scientific for analysis of TPH-DRO, TPH-GRO, BTEX, and Naphthalene by EPA Methods 8015 and 8260b. A base groundwater sample was also collected and analyzed for BTEX.
