General Comment:

This is a follow-up final reclamation, good housekeeping and stormwater inspection.

This inspection is to document compliance for the following corrective actions:

603.f: Noxious weed management.

This inspection is also in response to Form 18 complaint #200447500 in regards to noxious weed management on Foundation locations;

On 6/25/2019 complainant submitted a formal complaint Form 18 regarding noxious weed issues on location #447525, and #331849 (associated with battery #447523). Complaint was forwarded to inspector on 6/26/2019 and inspector made contact with complainant on 6/27/2019 at ~08:49 hours. Complainant stated that Foundation has failed to conduct sufficient and ongoing noxious weed monitoring and management, as Diffuse Knapweed (*Centaurea diffusa*) has continued to establish on the locations, and spread onto the adjacent lands. Complainant also indicated that Field Bindweed (*Convolvulus arvensis*) has become an issue.

On 7/1/2019, Inspector conducted a follow-up inspection, it was documented that *Centaurea diffusa* issues remain and that sufficient and ongoing noxious weed monitoring and management does not appear to be being conducted. Additionally, *Convolvulus arvensis* has established and spread throughout a large portion of the location. See "Good Housekeeping" within this report and attached photo document.

Comment:

Previous inspections documented that Diffuse Knapweed (*Centaurea diffusa*) have continued to establish on the location and access road and are encroaching onto the adjacent lands. Inspection required operator to properly remove and control noxious weeds on location. Inspection 696200159 on 6/04/2019 indicated that Knapweed remains on the location, though not as densely populated. This statement is partially incorrect; Knapweed remains on the location in abundance. Additionally, Field Bindweed (*Convolvulus arvensis*) has established and spread throughout a large portion of the location.

Sufficient and ongoing noxious weed monitoring and management is not occurring. Corrective action remains applicable.

Corrective Action:

Properly remove and control noxious weeds on location and adjacent lands where weeds have spread from the location. Ongoing weed management and monitoring is required, and needs to occur in accordance to COGCC rules and regulations.

The locations in reference are the Krager TB / well location and the SOONER SE SEC 21 TB location, both of which past complaints regarding noxious weed concerns (see inspection #682401201 and inspection #682401240).</p> <p>On 6/13/2018 at 15:09, upon receiving a formal complaint, Reclamation Specialist Trujillo contacted complainant via phone to discuss concerns. Complainant stated that operator has failed to perform weed management, and weeds (Diffuse Knapweed) has continued to grow and spread from the location onto their property</p>	trujilloam	07/02/2019
<p>On 8/3/2018, COGCC Field Inspector Evans contacted Reclamation Specialist Trujillo regarding weed issues. Evans stated that the Complainant was on location and made contact with him. Complainant indicated that sufficient weed management has not been conducted and that noxious weed issues remained.</p> <p>On 9/2/2018 Complainant contacted COGCC staff indicating locations have not received proper "good housekeeping". Complainant indicated that she personally bagged "21 garbage sacks of diffuse knapweed from this area".</p>	trujilloam	07/02/2019
