Rule 318 a. of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission requires that, on unspaced lands, wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 800 feet from any lease line, and located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply. Section 2, Township 11 North, Range 59 West, 6th P.M. is subject to Rule 318 a. for the Niobrara Formation.

On May 30, 2013, Dakota Exploration, LLC ("Dakota" or "Applicant"), by its attorneys, filed with the Commission pursuant to §34-80-116 C.R.S., a verified application ("Concurrent Application"), Docket No. 1307-SP-1140, for an order to establish an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for the below-described lands ("Application Lands"), and approve up to four horizontal wells within the unit, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.

Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or intervention to the person filing the application. One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of July 15, 2013. Pursuant to Rule 503.g, if a party who has received notice under Rule 503.b wishes to receive further pleadings in the above-referenced matter, that party must file a protest or intervention in accordance with these rules. In accordance with the practices of the Commission, should no protests or interventions be filed in this matter by July 15, 2013, the Applicant may request that an administrative hearing be scheduled beginning July 15, 2013. In the alternative, pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, the applicant may request, and the Director may recommend approval on the basis of the merits of the verified application and the supporting exhibits.

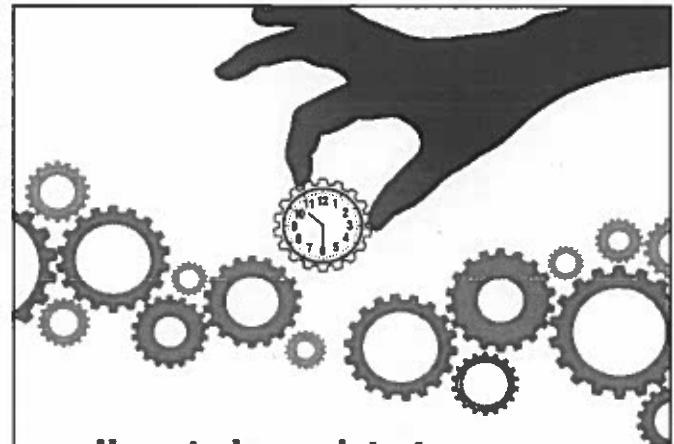
