TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On September 19, 2011, the Commission entered Order No. 535-75 which established four approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units and approved up to four horizontal wells within each unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation. Section 6, Township 9 North, Range 59 West, 6th P.M. is subject to this Order for the Niobrara Formation.

On March 25, 2013, the Commission entered Order No. 535-280 which approved up to six horizontal wells in an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation. Section 6, Township 9 North, Range 59 West, 6th P.M. is subject to this Order for the Niobrara Formation.

On March 25, 2013, the Commission entered Order No. 535-289 which pooled all interests in Section 6, Township 9 North, Range 59 West, 6th P.M. to accommodate the drilling of the Timbro Ranch 6-41-9-48 Well, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation.

On October 17, 2013, Whiting Oil and Gas Corporation ("Whiting" or "Applicant"), filed with the Commission pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., a verified application ("Application") for an order to approve the cost recovery provisions set forth in §34-60-116(7), C.R.S. for the below-described lands ("Application Lands") previously pooled by Order No. 535-289, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation, effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b)(ii), C.R.S. were first incurred for the drilling of the Wildhorse 08-0634H Well (API No. 05-123-34980) and the Wildhorse 08-0614H Well (API No. 05-123-34978) ("Wells").

In accordance with Rule 509, any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene on the application should file with the Commission a written protest or intervention no later than December 2, 2013, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or intervention to the person filing the application. One electronic (cogcc_hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of December 3, 2013. Pursuant to Rule 503.g., if a party who has received notice under Rule 503.b. wishes to receive further pleadings in the above-referenced matter, that party must file a protest or intervention in accordance with these rules. In accordance with the practices of the Commission, should no protests or interventions be filed in this matter by December 2, 2013, the Applicant may request that an administrative hearing be scheduled beginning December 3, 2013. In the alternative, pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, the applicant may request, and the Director may recommend approval on the basis of the merits of the verified application and the supporting exhibits.



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
