



Dear Sir:

This is a letter of agreement between yourself and El Paso Natural Gas Company to allow you to convert and operate the No. 1 Grover Swift well as a water well.

The Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission requires that you assume the responsibility of operation of the said well located 660' South of North line and 660' West of East line, Section 6, Township 24S, Range 51W, 6th Meridian, Bent County, Colorado, after El Paso Natural Gas Company has plugged for abandonment from total depth to the bottom of surface casing set at 455'.

El Paso Natural Gas Company will plug this well in a manner approved by the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission and then turn the well over to you for operation.
