Operator Comment: After receiving a number of COGCC inspections related to varying amounts of "trash" on location, Laramie incorporated an aggressive process improvement methodology to all field operations. Laramie is confounded and confused as to why a trash can, used to keep the location tidy and free from debris is being noted as a Corrective Action for "stored equipment".

COGCC Decision: Approved pending re-inspection

Representative:

Loren that the rule says all locations should be kept free of rubbish and other waste. It does not say add another piece of equipment so that you can store more waste and rubbish. Why can't operators and contractors remove waste as they finish at the end of each day. The trash cans are unlikely to work well in winter weather and if they have oily waste or possibly other liquids it could create an issue. Food waste would be a significant problem even if not within SWA for bears.  
Flexibility could be made if Laramie has a really strong program on picking up the cans and making sure no human type food gets in them and trash containers were wildlife safe.
