General Comment:

On July 26, 2019, COGCC Environmental Staff (John Heil and Steven Arauza) conducted an environmental field inspection of NONSUCH NATURAL GAS INC (Nonsuch operator #10163) Location ID 324172.

COGCC staff observed six holes in the liner of the tank battery secondary containment ranging from one to four inches in diameter, vegetation in the tank battery secondary containment, a hole in the pit netting and an open access gate to the pit on location (See photos). GOCGG staff also observed sediment encroaching into the pit and hydrocarbons on the pit liner and fluids.
