SRC Energy hereby certifies that it has complied with Rule 306.e, which states that an Operator shall be available to meet with building unit owners who received an OGLA notice or a buffer zone notice pursuant to Rule 305.c. and requested a meeting regarding the proposed oil and gas location.

SRC Energy notified all BU's, LGD, and the Surface Owner the Buffer Notice on February 21, 2019. While no consultations were formally requested, SRC was required to hold this neighborhood meeting per City of Greeley's Use By Special Review process.

SRC held a neighborhood meeting per City of Greeley's Use by Special Review regulations on December 12, 2018. Per COGCC and City of Greeley regulations, notice was given to all Building Units within 500 feet of the subject property. However, this meeting information was also made public via publication in the local paper, as well as a posted sign at the subject property, providing the community with the time and date of the neighborhood meeting. Attendance to the neighborhood meeting was minimal, with no negative feedback from the community regarding the site location.

SRC respectfully requests that the Director approve of the 2A and wells on the Ridge State 33-16 Pad
