



Do not begin operations until approved copy has been received. It is mandatory that the proposed location comply with all rules and regulations of the Commission. Locate well on section grid in proper location, and indicate extent of lease. Unless operations are commenced within 180 days after the date of approval hereof, this approval to drill will become null and void.
