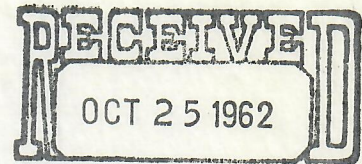

APPLICATION FOR ABANDONMENT

Comes now Graham-Michaelis Drilling Company, as a Class B independent producer, as defined in Order No. 174-B, with its business address and principal place of business at 211 North Broadway, Wichita, Kansas, and shows the Commission as follows:

1. That applicant herein is a partnership consisting of William L. Graham, Marjorie Lois Graham and W. A. Michaelis Jr., doing business as Graham-Michaelis Drilling Company; that applicant is authorized to do business within the State of Colorado.

2. The person responsible for this application and the party to whom communications may be addressed with regard to the same is W. A. Michaelis, Jr., general partner of the applicant, whose office is at the location of the principal place of business of applicant, 211 North Broadway, Wichita, Kansas. Copies of such communications should be sent to Collins, Hughes, Martin, Pringle & Schell, 508 Petroleum Building, Wichita 2, Kansas.

3. Applicant previously filed an application pur-



uant to Order No. 174-B which was docketed in Docket No. G-19973, wherein certificate of authority was sought to produce and sell natural gas from certain gas wells in Julesburg Basin area in Colorado, included in which was the following described acreage:

Lyle Scott #1:	West Half (W/2) of Section 3, Township 3 North, Range 48 West, Logan County, Colorado
Clyde Haynes #1:	West Half (W/2) of Section 14, Township 3 North, Range 48 West Logan County, Colorado

4. Pursuant to the application referred to above, the Commission subsequently issued its letter of temporary authority in said docket number which was dated October 29, 1959.

5. Applicant now states that the wells located on the units described in Paragraph 3 above has encountered large amounts of water in connection with the production; that said wells were originally a small well and that the intrusion of water has been such that the same is no longer capable of producing gas. For this reason the available supply of natural gas is depleted to the extent that the continuance of service is unwarranted and applicant desires authority to abandon said wells pursuant to Section 157.30 of the Commission's rules and regulations.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays that the application be disposed of in accordance with the shortened procedure provided for in Section 1.32 of the Commission's General Rules and Regulations and that an order be issued authorizing applicant to abandon the



above described well and the service regarding the same.

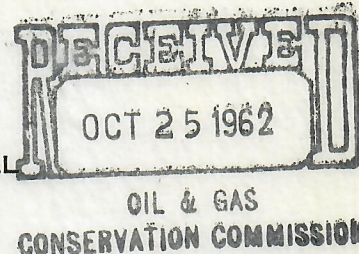
