Received your prompt reply to my letter of November 4, 1964, regarding the #1 Duell located in Section 25, Township 8 North, Range 60 West, Buckingham-West field.

It appears that you have some trouble following the rules and regulations of this Commission, and with the thought that you may have lost your copy I am enclosing a new booklet for your use.

You will note that you have been given a violation on your Producer's Certificate of Clearance that you submitted. This is not because you filed only two copies where the form clearly states three, it is because Rule 310, page 13, clearly states that the certificate is to be filed as soon as practicable and upon the change of transporter.

Second, you indicate Resler Petroleum Company is submitting the levy. Neither our records or those of the Department of Revenue indicate that this is actually occurring.

Third, the law, as shown on page 73, pertaining to levy reports clearly states in paragraph 2 "On or before the 20th day of each month every producer of oil or natural gas shall file the report with the commission....."

Your prompt attention this matter will be appreciated.
