Corrective action was not completed since previous inspection. Noxious weeds have now developed seed heads which must be cut, bagged, removed, and controlled. See Attached Photos

Comment:	Due to the extent of noxious weed infestation found field wide. The operator must submit a weed control plan for ongoing weed control practice.
