





This letter is in regards to the conservation of our land and protection of our rights.

On April 17, 1981, our land was leased by Dean Cummins of Piedmont Exploration, Inc. for 3 years. It is located in Weld Co., Colo. Township 7 North, Range 59 West, 6th P.M. Section 10: SE 1/4. Our papers call it Leonard #1 well in Wildcat Field (Buckingham Valley). The drilling exploration was done in January 1982 and apparently the results were unsatisfactory as they moved off the land. However, this well was left open to the surface and the pits have never been closed.
