ROMAC owns working interests varying from 22 percent to 37.5 percent in the following wells:

Enstar 29-1 Vern Harley Sec. 29-T9N-R52W ✓
KEE 4-1 Finnigsmier Sec. 4-T8N-R48W
KEE 1 Goddard Sec. 4-T8N-T48W


All of these wells are extremely water sensitive and as a result of frequent shut-in practices by KNEnergy, serious water problems are developing. Experienced operators in this area are well aware of the damage that can be caused by repeated shut-in practices and it is my understanding that certain similar wells in the Sterling, Colorado, area have been allowed to sell gas on a continuing basis in order to avoid this type of damage.

In the interests of good gas field practice and conservation, we are requesting that the above-named wells be allowed to sell gas on a steady basis in the future so that the maximum amount of gas may be recovered thus avoiding premature abandonment.
