Dear Mr. Tyler:

I just recently heard of the untimely death of Mr. R. G. Houser, and needless to say, it was quite a shock.

I have been advised by Mr. George Hopper that you are the Vice President of the Hauser Drilling Co., Inc., and thought perhaps you could handle this matter.

As you know, Mr. Houser recently drilled the No. 2 H. D. Lauer, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 12, T-7N, R-59W. This well was drilled under the bonding provisions for Allison Drilling Co., Inc., the contractor. Subsequently, Mr. Houser advised that about July 19, 1964, he would post the \$2500 bond required.

I understand that you are to acidize the well by August 15, 1964, and will at that time decide whether or not to plug it. Of course, you would have to have approval of this office prior to plugging, and can make arrangements for the bonding if you are going on with the attempts for completion.

We are most anxious to straighten this out, and would appreciate any assistance you might give us in this matter.
