Dear Mr. Greer:

There have been some new developments pertaining to the #2 H. D. Lauer well located in the NE NW section 12, township 7 north, range 59 west since I last wrote you in November 1964.

On December 10, 1964, John T. Dixon of P.O. Box 467, Sterling, Colorado filed a Form 10 and bond. The Form 10 as approved designates him the new operator and it indicated the transporter of oil would be Fowler Petroleum Company of Denver.

He has filed production reports indicating production of 46 barrels of oil and 5 water in November, 60 oil and 6 water in December, and 31 oil and no water in January.
