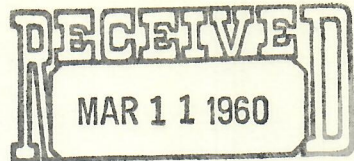

	May 30th, 1926. Bridged back to 2812 and waiting for shot. Well shot June 5th, with 100 qts. Nitro but did not held at all that could be noticed. Well had about fifty feet of oil in it when shot was put in. June 8th, 1926. Pulled all 6 1/2" casing. Plugged back at 1500 feet. Put in 50 ft. of rock and dirt on top of bridge and dumped six sacks of cement on top of this. Pulled all 8 1/2" casing and 12 1/2" casing. Celler to be filled and pipe marker left as soon as rig is moved.
