

Dear Mr. Rogers:

We have received from your department letter of January 28, 1959, copy of which is attached, advising that our bond dated October 14, 1957, covering the #2 V. O. Morton lease is released as of January 27, 1959.

On November 24, 1958, your department advised us by letter of that date, copy of which is attached, that our bond covering the #1 Morton well could be released as of June 16, 1958. We checked with your department to see which of our bonds this release pertained to and you advised it was bond dated October 14, 1957.

We do not have in our file another bond dated October 14, 1957, covering any well located in this section of land. We do have one dated February 2, 1958, on the #3 Morton well, on which to date we have not received notification of release.

If your records show that two bonds are on file in your department, each dated October 14, 1957, one covering the #1 Morton and one covering the #2 Morton, we would


