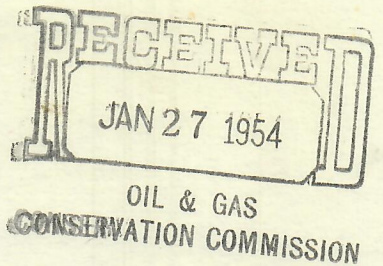

We propose to chemically treat the above well in an attempt to increase its productive
 capacity by dissolving paraffinic material which is thought to have been deposited
 opposite the casing perforations.

This treatment will consist of 200 gallons of Dowell parafin solvent P-4.

During the latest 24 hour production test the well pumped one barrel and no water.

Propose to increase well productive capacity.
