

The well is located 1980 ft. (N) of South Line and 660 ft. (E) of West Line of Sec. 28 (S) (W)

The elevation above sea level is 4187 ft. KB

Details of Plan of Work: (State names of and expected depths to objective sands; Show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

Drilled to T.D. 5178' KB, January 11, 1954. Tested all zones and found none to be commercially productive. Ran in hole with open ended drill pipe and placed 40 sacks cement plug from 5138-4864' KB and 10 sacks cement plug from 27' to 8' KB. Welded steel plate over surface pipe. Well plugged and abandoned January 15, 1954
