I have inspected the site of a proposed oil well in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 8-9-53 and find that this location is well above the high water line of the North Sterling Reservoir.

The ground slope to the Reservoir at this site is very steep. The operator has constructed a reserve slush pit which would trap any materials before they reached the Reservoir in the event the main pit fails. We appreciate the extra efforts that have been made at this location.
