



MEMO

NW SE NE, 10 - 8S - 76W

This well site was inspected by me on September 3, 1957.

A pit has been dozed open to a depth of about six feet and 50 feet long. The pit contains about a foot of water.

A circular cellar was dug and shored up. This cellar is about 10 feet deep and six feet across. Water stands in the cellar about 2 feet deep.

Thirteen inch casing has been set and left open. A 4" x 12" plank has been placed over the casing and held in place by a large link chain. The water level in the casing is about four feet below the level of the water in the cellar.

The original lease owner has agreed to level the site this fall. Mr. Schottinger wants the casing left open so he can use the hole as a water well.

When we receive the letter from Mr. Schottinger assuming responsibility for the well, the bond can be released.
