In Weld County Code he is allowed 1 access point to a County Road per parcel, which nullifies the one he has falsely claimed to be able to use, that goes directly south of his site across Sandstead's and Krafft's property where an electric gate has been installed. They are using Rasmussen's property to do something with Regnier's Facility site and currently don't have any right to do so. The hubris of the Crestone Peak, it's as though they thing they are above and beyond property ownership, as though they can do whatever they want because they have a small non-working well thing they that it's somehow theirs and not Rasmussen's, like it's neutral ground.
