Nick and Diane,

It seems for the Coland State 9-16 well we did not obtain a true Form 17 before starting P&A Operations on this well. We have set production plugs downhole but the surface casing has not been altered. We are moving the rig off location and will shut the well in for 7 days and then obtain the Form 17 on November 8th before we move back on the well again. It will not be a true Form 17 unfortunately, but it will at least let us obtain a measure of the surface casing pressures.

We wanted to let you know as soon as possible about this miscommunications that occurred in our process and are working to rectify it the best we can for this well.

Please let us know if there is anything else we can do for this particular Form 17.
