Composite soil analysis was submitted previously, see attachments.

Additional samples were obtained in 2018 to confirm composite results. 3 samples were obtained (see attachments for GPS coordinates and sample information) and meet Table 910-1 requirements. 2 sidewall samples were taken, one pit bottom sample was taken. Due to the line entrance not being indicated on the site facility diagram, therefore being unknown, samples were taken from the walls most likely to have been impacted. Offsite samples were obtained during composite sampling, see attached.

A visual inspection was performed looking for signs of stained soil and potential leeching of pit components that may have impacted surface or groundwater, none were found. No groundwater was encountered during sampling.
