On May 14, 1982, Coors Energy Company, by its attorney, filed with the Commission an order to establish 640-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Mesa-verde formation (including the Cozetta and Corcoran members), common source of supply underlying the following described lands in Mesa County, Colorado, to-wit: Township 8 South, Range 92 West, 6th P.M. }

and further providing that each unit consist of 640-acre, more or less, and consist of a section of land, according to the governmental survey and the permitted well be located no closer than 600 feet from the boundaries of the section upon which it is located. It is further requested that Well No. USA 1-16 SC, located 519 feet from the north line and 1288 feet from the west line of said Section 16, be considered an exception and be the permitted well for the unit upon which it is located.
