General Comment:

On 1/22/2020 Catherine Roy conducted a reclamation and stormwater inspection in coordination with Reclamation Supervisor Denise Arthur.

The following corrective actions identified during the November 12, 2019 reclamation inspection are not addressed. Corrective action dates are back-dated to the November 12, 2019 inspection date, to document duration of non-compliance.

- Revegetation needs to be conducted within the interim reclamation areas.
- Weeds need to be controlled
- Stormwater and erosion controls are needed to stabilize erosion throughout the project area.
- Additionally, metal debris was identified and needs to be removed by February 7, 2020.
