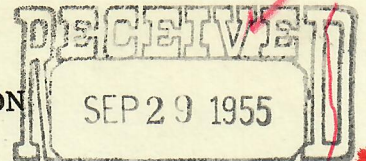

Well was spudded Sept. 15, 1955. 430' of 10 3/4" surface casing was cemented with 350 sacks of common cement. 50' core was cut in the "D" sand from 6110 to 6160. 43' core was cut in the "J" sand from 6230-6273. No Drill Stem Tests were run.

Well was drilled to the Skull Creek Formation-Total Depth 6331. Plugged and abandoned Sept. 26, 1955. 25 sacks of cement in the Dakota, hole filled with heavy drilling mud, 10 sacks of cement at bottom of surface casing, 5 sacks of cement at top of surface casing steel plate welded to top of surface casing.
